**MEMORANDUM FOR THE COMMANDER, NAVAL SEA SYSTEMS COMMAND**

**SUBJECT: Approval to Extend the Performance Period of SeaPort and SeaPort-e Task and Delivery Orders Issued Under SeaPort and SeaPort-e Indefinite Delivery, Indefinite Quantity Contracts**

Pursuant to Defense Federal Acquisition Regulation Supplement (DFARS) 217.204(e)(iii), I approve the issuance of task or delivery orders under the Naval Sea Systems Command SeaPort and SeaPort-e IDIQ contracts with a performance period of up to five years, including any option periods, notwithstanding that performance under the order might be expected to extend more than 1 year beyond the 10-year limit for the ordering period of task or delivery order contracts provided in DFARS 217.204(e)(i). This approval applies only to SeaPort and SeaPort-e task or delivery orders issued on or before December 31, 2019.
