

CTII Question and Answers
Industry Day – 10 December 2013

1. Does the contractor pay any rental/usage fee for tools contained in the Government facilities? *No. Limited test equipment is available for checkout.*
2. (a) Does the contractor perform any production, test or integration activities in the contractor facilities, or are the prescribed contractor facilities used for office space? *Yes production of racks, fabrication of cables and procurement of material can be done in contractor facilities.*
(b) Can contractor perform production at Government facility? *Yes, based on space availability.*
3. Can you clarify the SB requirements as far as percentages? *The SB percentages are based on SPAWAR HQ annual goals and are broken out by 37% for overall small business. The table then identifies goals for other areas: SBD 5%, WOSB 5%, VOSB 3%, HUB zone 3%, and SDVOSB 1%.*
4. Who is the Source Selection Authority? *Govt cannot disclose any members of the source selection team to include the SSA.*
5. What is the anticipated value of this contract? *In Section L we are providing the offerors with the number of hours by labor category along with ceiling caps for the ODCs CLIN. Based on all this information already provided, the Govt is not going to provide the total value of contract.*
6. Can Charleston contractor production facilities be owned/operated by a subcontractor? *Yes.*
7. Will slide presentation be posted on e-commerce? *Yes.*
8. Are recently publish contractor parking applicable to the facilities? *Yes. Here is the SSC Lant language that has been posted, " NOTICE TO CONTRACTORS WORKING IN CHARLESTON SC - EFFECTIVE 1 DEC 2013:*

The Government will no longer provide parking arrangements for contractor employees who work in SSC Atlantic's North Yard vicinity (i.e. Bldgs. 1648, 1602, 1603, 1620, 1621, etc.) at the old Naval Base in Charleston SC. It will be each contractor's responsibility to provide parking for their employees working in this area. For contractor employees who are handicapped or have special needs, the contractor should contact the COR for the task order under which the employee works to determine if any special arrangements can be made for that employee on a case-by-case basis.

NOTE: Contractors with current access will not lose access to the North Yard."

9. Is the TIF also used as an engineering design facility for these ships systems, or is that development work conducted at a different facility? If so, where? *No, TIF is utilized for primarily production and validation of the design. If design work is required it will be identified in the individual task order. Office space is not provided inside the TIF / BLDG 1648.*
