1		How is the Government going to ensure competitive pricing for the High Power Amplifier, 622-7961-031, as the incumbent is the only manufacturer?	SPAWAR cannot guarantee the pricing of a component or assembly that is not provided as Government Furnished Equipment. The High Power Amplifier may be bought or made to fulfill this requirement. The TDP contains the design and CLINs 0200 and 0300 were intended to address any production or obsolescence needs as they relate to a make or buy decision.
2		Due to the size of the Technical Data Package and volume of Bill of Material line items, will the Government extend the proposal due date by two weeks?	Yes. The proposal was extended via Amendment 0001 to 11 Aug 2014.
3		There appears to be a conflict in the RFP. Can you please confirm whether certified cost or pricing data is required?	Certified cost or pricing data is not required. See RFP page 119 of 126. Clause 52.215-20 Requirements for Certified Cost or Pricing Data and Data Other Than Certified Cost or Pricing Data (Oct 2010) , Alt IV. Paragraph (a) states, "Submission of certified cost or pricing data is not required. Contract Clause 52.215-20 on page 115 of the RFP will be deleted via Amendment 0001.

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<b>4</b>		<p>Page 15 of the RFP defines the Delivery Date as 12 ADOA for CLIN 0100. Page 41, Clause 52.216-18, says that orders can be placed through 24 months after Contract award. Our interpretation of these two (2) clauses seem to indicate that the overall period of performance for the overall Contract could be up to 36 months (12 months ADOA plus 24 in clause 52.216-18. Is this correct?</p>	<p>Clause 52.211-8 requires delivery of CLIN 0100 units within 12 months after delivery order award (ADOA). This is the required due date for CLIN 0100 units after a unit is ordered by delivery order.</p> <p>Clause 52.216-18 allows for orders to be placed within 24 months after the award date. This is the ordering period.</p> <p>Clause 52.216-22 allows for 24 additional months to make deliveries after the ordering period expires as defined in 52.216-18. This is sometimes called the “clean-up” period. No new orders may be placed but work may continue on orders awarded during the ordering period.</p> <p>The total possible period of performance for orders, delivery and “clean-up” is 48 months.</p>

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<b>5</b>		<p>As part of the RFP package there was an Attachment 7 (Reference Information sheet). Is this required to be completed by the offeror and submitted with our proposal? There is no instructions and I have never seen the document before with any RFP with SPAWAR. Please advise.</p>	<p>Yes. Attachment 7 is required as a key part of the LPTA evaluation. It is referenced in “L-317 SUBMISSION OF PROPOSALS (COMPLEX) (JUL 1999)”</p> <p>...</p> <p><b>Factor 2 – Relevant Organizational Experience.</b>  The Offeror shall provide a description of those recent efforts (within the last five years) that best demonstrate management, cost, schedule, and technical experience relevant to the kinds of challenges in size and scope under the contract contemplated by this RFP. Each referenced contract shall be described using separately completed copies of RFP Attachment 7, Reference Information Sheet. RFP Attachment 7 will allow for each referenced contract to be accompanied by a maximum of six additional pages...</p> <p>Attachment 7 is also referenced in “M-304 AWARD (LOWEST PRICE, TECHNICALLY ACCEPTABLE) (DEC 1999)”</p> <p>...</p> <p><b>FACTOR 2 – Relevant Organizational Experience.</b>  This acceptability criteria is an evaluation of the offeror’s organizational experience relevant to the kinds of challenges in size and scope under the contract contemplated by this RFP. In order to be determined acceptable, the offeror shall demonstrate relevant experience in each of the last five (5) years. This evaluation will consider the relevance of the offeror’s experience as submitted using Contract Attachment 7.</p>

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6		What is the required validity period for proposals?	<p>L-335 ESTIMATED EFFECTIVE AWARD DATE (DEC 1999)            For Bidding/Proposal purposes the estimated effective date of contract award is 1<sup>st</sup> Quarter FY 2015.            (End of provision)</p> <p>Amendment 0001 clarifies this provision by adding,            "Proposals shall be valid through 31 December 2014."</p>
