#	QUESTION(S) FROM INDUSTRY	GOVERNMENT RESPONSE
1	<p>PARAPHRASE: Industry would like clarification on whether or not the Government intends to publish all feedback from Industry or just publish questions of a general nature. If Government publishes all feedback, Industry is concerned about sharing company's competition sensitive information with the Government.</p>	<ol style="list-style-type: none">1. The Government intends to publish all answers that the Government provides to questions of a general nature received from Industry. Those questions would include clarification of the draft RFP that the Government believes is necessary to receive helpful responses from Industry. The Government will not publish proprietary information in accordance with FAR 3.104.2. The Government intends to use feedback received on any of the draft RFP documents to make improvements on the overall RFP package. The Government will adjudicate the comments from Industry and may make any necessary changes to the documents the Government deems would improve the final RFP package. The Government will not publish the feedback received from Industry on the ecommerce website.3. If any information provided by Industry is marked as PROPRIETARY, then such information will be protected in accordance with FAR 3.104.4. If Industry marks any questions to the Government as PROPRIETARY, then the Government will withhold providing any responses to those questions. An alternative path is for Industry to approach those questions in forms of feedback to the RFP package. As noted above, the Government will not publish the feedback from Industry on the ecommerce website.
