- a. The acronym "IOT&E" is replaced by "OT&E" for every instance in the document.
- b. Section C - Descriptions and Specifications, Section 2 – Scope is hereby changed from:

The contractor will provide an OTS EHR System. The contractor will support integration, configuration, testing, training, and sustainment for the EHR System. At a minimum, the EHR System will replace functionality of core legacy systems, and satisfy the requirements to enable enterprise deployment to both fixed and operational medicine treatment facilities. The solution will be installed in a Government Test Lab for integration with DoD environment and "developmental" testing activities prior to achieving approval for IOT&E.
