- 1) In Table 4.1 of the SPS, the data rates above 44.73 Mb/s were changed to Objective in the Rev H-2 column; however, they were not changed to Objective in the Rev F-1 column. We request that this change be made to the SPS.

*Answer: Changes were made see Amendment 0002.*

- 2) In Section 4.6 of the SPS, the requirement for JTIC certification was changed to add "for systems complying with Std CDL spec Rev F-1 at a minimum, and rev H-2 (O)". This is inconsistent with the RFP Amendment 0001, Section L, MANDATORY REQUIREMENT, which requires FAT or Government certifications for CDL Waveform that meet Std-CDL Rev [H-2]. Cubic requests that the MANDATORY REQUIREMENT be changed to Std-CDL Rev F-1.

*Answer: Change was made see Amendment 0002.*

- 3) Also, if the threshold is now 45Mbps, we would assume the gigabit Ethernet requirement listed in "mandatory requirements" is eliminated. Is this a correct assumption - could you clarify this point as well please?

*No, the gigabit Ethernet requirement remains unchanged in order to allow for future system upgrades.*

- 4) What test documentation (e.g. First Article Test Report) would suffice to demonstrate that an offeror's PCDL system meets the mandatory requirements?

*The Government will accept tests reports to include vendor test results.*
