The Global – Theater Security Cooperation Management Information System (G-TSCMIS) is a program of record in the Navy's Program Management, Warfare, Command and Control Program Office (PMW 150). G-TSCMIS is the Department of Defense's (DoD) enterprise system for planning, recording, tracking, and assessing effectiveness of the nation's Security Cooperation (SC) efforts executed to support the Global Employment for Forces doctrine approved by the Secretary of Defense. G-TSCMIS is the information technology link for information sharing and collaboration within and between the DoD and Department of State, supporting military and non-military elements of national power.

G-TSCMIS Releases 1 and 2 are under development with expected fielding dates in 2013 and 2015. After G-TSCMIS Release 2 development concludes and is fielded, the Government anticipates awarding development of Releases 3 through 5 using either full and open or fair opportunity competition. To facilitate competition, PMW 150 is releasing key requirement and program office documents with this market survey. Prior to solicitation of Releases 3 through 5, the Government may update this market survey with additional information. This market survey will serve as a central repository for Release 3 through 5 information to be shared with industry to foster understanding of the requirements and competition on future G-TSCMIS solicitations.

At this time, the Government does not intend to release existing software, source code, technical data, other technical documentation, or similar materials as part of this market survey. The Government plans to release some of this information in tandem with any solicitation(s) for Releases 3 through 5. Additionally, although Releases 3 through 5 will build on capabilities developed for Releases 1 and 2, the developer(s) of Releases 3 through 5 is not required to use the Release 1 and 2 software to develop the remaining releases.
