**Obtaining access to the Maritime Patrol and Reconnaissance Forces (MPRF) ISR Enhancements through an Enterprise Expeditionary Operations Architecture (MEEOA) Project Site on NESI**

In the near future, the Government will provide technical documentation pertaining to the MEEOA Broad Agency Announcement (BAA) for industry review on a separate, secured, access-controlled website restricted to Department of Defense (DoD) contractors. A notice will be posted on the SPAWAR e-Commerce site to alert industry when the documents are available on the secured site.

In order to request access to the secured website, contractors shall complete the “MEEOA Bidder’s Repository Use and Non-Disclosure Agreement (NDA)” posted on the SPAWAR e-Commerce website. Each company may request access for up to two (2) authorized Technical Points of Contact (POCs). The signed NDA, along with the e-mail address and phone number for each requested POC, should be returned to Patricia Ponce-Feliu at [patricia.poncefeliu@navy.mil](mailto:patricia.poncefeliu@navy.mil), with a copy provided to Fred Renz at [frederick.renz@navy.mil](mailto:frederick.renz@navy.mil). Access to the secured website is restricted to U.S. DoD contractors with a valid DoD or External Certificate Authority (ECA) issued Public Key Infrastructure (PKI) certificate. U.S. DoD contractors who do not have a valid DoD or ECA-issued PKI certificate should contact LCDR Scott Murray at [scott.murray@navy.mil](mailto:scott.murray@navy.mil) for further instructions.

Once the NDAs are received and the company’s status as a U.S. DoD contractor is verified, the Government will provide instructions on how to access the secured site to the approved POCs. Note that additional or updated documentation may be posted to the site after the initial documents have been posted; therefore it is the responsibility of any interested party to monitor the site for any additional postings. The MEEOA BAA will be released in October 2009.
